Mass Offerings: Mass Intentions. each time he offers Mass the priest can offer it for a specified intention. Such as for someone who has died, for good health for a sick person, or in thanksgiving for graces received, These are the intentions listed in the weekly Mass Sheet and are usually announced at the beginning of the Mass. This ancient practice benefits both the faithful and the person for whom prayer is asked (the mass is the greatest prayer of intercession. to book Masses, To book a Mass Intention please use one of the envelopes available in the porch area of the church or indeed any envelopes. Write the intention on it with date required for Mass and your name and contact details if you want the mass confirmed and enclose the donation. Hand the intention to Father Paul or post through the Presbytery door if you can, or alternatively leave them in the Sacristy. **We currently have lots of dates free for your Mass intentions.**

After their ordination, our priests dedicate their lives to serving Christ and His people in our parishes, hospitals, schools, chaplaincies, prisons and in service to the needy, throughout South London, Kent and Surrey. We are blessed to have 6 men in formation to the Priesthood for our Archdiocese. However, it costs £30,000 a year to sponsor each seminarian. They study for 6 years before being ordained a Catholic priest. We therefore rely on your generous support and prayers.
