Changes in Marriage Registration. From May 6th the government introduced a new way to register solemnised Marriages. Through this change the paper documentations have been scrapped replaced by Digital Registration. Therefore, places of Marriage such as Churches or halls will no longer issue Marriage Certificates that will now be issued by the Local Council.
