The Synod: The task of putting together all the reports from the parishes has started. Last week in a series of meetings all the parishes from the Archdiocese had 4 minutes to present their brief reflections. We will be submitting our parish written report by 18th February. We will make this available to you. Everything will then be reviewed by the Synod group and all the delegates are invited to hear the results on 17th March.
