The Synod This Sunday, 17 October 2021, Archbishop John Wilson will launch the Synodal Process in Southwark with a livestreamed Mass at St George's Cathedral (10am – link here: <https://youtu.be/aiCHG9JugaY>). The pastoral letter for this will be read this weekend and is available in the porch. In the Archbishop's letter (1 October), introducing the Synodal Process, each parish was invited to nominate two delegates to serve during the local listening (parish/diocesan) phase.
