Consecration of Russia and Ukraine: Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has announced that he will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of our Blessed Lady on Friday, 25 March, the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. This will occur during a 'Celebration of Penance' over which he will preside at 4pm in the Basilica of St Peter. This act of consecration will be performed in communion with the local Churches throughout the world, and so at 4pm that same day, Archbishop John will lead our archdiocese in prayer, and himself preside at a service of consecration followed by a 'Rosary for Peace' in Southwark's Cathedral of St George.
