We do this in solidarity with so many others on whom are being imposed restrictions which impact severely on their lives and livelihoods.

At this difficult moment, we ask that, as a Catholic community, we make full use of our churches as places of individual prayer and sources of solace and help. We must sustain each other in our patterns of prayer, joining a national shared moment of prayer each day at 6pm, and observing the Vigil of Christ the King which is on the 21st November as a day of prayer for the ending of this pandemic.”
