The support fund of the Archdiocese of Southwark provides care for priests in their old age and retirement, and in their time of ill health. **Lent Saving Grace Retreat:** The Archdiocese of Southwark is offering a retreat experience for its people and parishes during Lent 2022, beginning on the first Sunday of Lent and ending in Easter week. Drawing on the Old Testament readings for the Sundays of Lent, Saving Grace will explore our shared story as the people of God. This is a flexible resource that can be delivered entirely online if needed. The retreat will enable you to deliver a Lent programme with minimal effort on your part. Each week we will: Release a video that your parishioners can view from their homes via a link in your newsletter; or they can sign up independently to have it directly emailed to them.

Release resources for individual prayer and reflection. These can be accessed online by parishioners, or hard copies can be printed and distributed for those who do not have the internet.

Weekly group sessions will allow people to share their experiences as they take part in the retreat. For parishes wishing to run their own online or in person groups some simple guidelines are available here.

Individuals can also access Zoom groups organised by the Spirituality Commission. These will run on different days or the week and times of the day and last for up to an hour.
