Contactless Giving: This device/machine is now installed at the back of the chuch. Those who would like to use it are welcome. It works like any pay machine we use anywhere.

Maundy Thursday: The Washing of the Feet is to be omitted and there is to be no procession to the Altar of Repose. The Reserved Sacrament to be kept in the Tabernacle of the church.

Good Friday: The Service will be as usual except for *The Adoration of the Holy Cross*, the Cross can either be veiled or unveiled according to what form of the *Showing* is used. For the *Adoration*, the Veneration of the Cross is limited to the celebrant alone. After he has done this, he should "invite the people present in a few words to adore the Holy Cross and afterwards, holds the Cross elevated higher for a brief time, for the faithful to adore in silence." This may be expressed by the faithful through a short period of silent prayer, a gesture such as a genuflection or bow followed by another period of silent prayer.

The Easter Vigil: For the celebration of the Easter Vigil, the Paschal candle should be prepared, enthroned and lit in the Sanctuary before the people gather in the church, or simply lit at the beginning of the celebration. The ministers should process in silence to the sanctuary where Mass begins. Easter Proclamation (the *Exultate*) immediately follows. The faithful should not have votive candles for the Easter Vigil. The Liturgy of the Word follows. The celebrant should bless the baptismal water in the font. The Renewal of Baptismal Promises should be made by those present, but faithful should not be sprinkled with the Holy Water.
