Each week we will: Release a video that your parishioners can view from their homes via a link in your newsletter; or they can sign up independently to have it directly emailed to them.

Release resources for individual prayer and reflection. These can be accessed online by parishioners, or hard copies can be printed and distributed for those who do not have the internet.

Weekly group sessions will allow people to share their experiences as they take part in the retreat. For parishes wishing to run their own online or in person groups some simple guidelines are available here.

Individuals can also access Zoom groups organised by the Spirituality Commission. These will run on different days or the week and times of the day and last for up to an hour.
