**Mass:** At the moment there is no need for you to book to be for Mass as attendance and numbers are still manageable. However, to help control and manage future incidences of infection in the unlikely event of an outbreak you have to register attendance (**do come with a pen, a name and phone contact details are sufficient**) at each Mass to help the NHS Test and Trace programme. Forms are on the pews or can be downloaded from the Website and dropped at Mass time. **Drop the forms in the basket on your left as you enter the church in the porch and will be kept and destroyed after 21 days.**

### Face Coverings:

Face coverings will be mandatory in Places of Worship from Saturday 8th August 2020. All those who are attending churches must wear a face covering unless they are exempt from doing so. This is for the good of all, as it is an enclosed public space where there are people from differing households who they do not normally meet. Four (4) Priests in the sanctuary providing they are sufficiently distant (2m or more) from the congregation do not need to wear a face covering except when distributing Holy Communion. Other ministers in the sanctuary should wear face coverings and remain socially distant from the celebrant.
